DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Flint Hill Methodist Church is a one and a half story frame structure which faces east from the west side of Park Mills Road in Flint Hill.

The building is two bays wide and three bays long; an extension tower with belfry is located in the second bay on the east side and projects from the front plane of the building. The main entrance a six panel double door with segmented triangular light transom is located on the east side of the tower. Three double hung gothic windows are located in the first bay on the east side of the building and on either side of the extension tower. The east gable and top half of the tower is decorated with fish scale framework; a round window is located in the gable, double hung gothic windows decorated each side of the tower. The north and south sides of the building are identical; each three bays wide with segmented double hung gothic windows occupying each bay. The entire building, is built on a high coursed stone foundation; the tin roof is finished by a plain cornice. A cornerstone in the southeast corner states "Flint Hill Church 1898".


