DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Tenth Vermont Infantry Monument is a small monument on the west corner of Baker Valley Road and Araby Church Road and faces northeast.

It is a large granite block on a two step granite platform on the top of an embankment. Three granite steps lead up to the monument which sits about ten feet from the roadway. Inset into the monument is a bronze plaque which states "Erected 1915 Seven Companies occupied the Washington Pike, these companies occupied the Buckeystown Road opposite the Thomas House.


