In 1839, one-half an acre and two square perches of land "for the site of a primary school in the district" was donated to the trustees of the Primary School District #66 by William and Harriet Williams.

The Pleasant Hill School, a one story rectangular common bond brick structure was built in its present location soon after the purchase, since it is identified on the 1873 Titus Map of Frederick County. The school was in use until the 1920's and sold by the school board in 1931. The school was later converted into a private residence.

DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Pleasant Hill School is a one story rectangular brick structure with small closed entrance addition laid in common bond which is located on the west side of the Green Valley Road (Route 75) just south of Monrovia.

Although the old school building has been converted to a private residence the structure has undergone only minor changes.

The main part of the structure is three bays long with double hung wood lintelled 6/6 windows located in each bay on the north side . The center bay on the south side has been changed to a modern doorway covered by an open shed roofed porch which extends along the entire length of the building.

A small brick chimney rises from the center of the tin gabled roof which is attached to the main structure by a stepped brick cornice. The original main entrance to the building has been boarded closed. The entire building is constructed on a low random stone foundation.


