DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This is a detached row of two story detached frame houses with low peaked roofs eight bays wide and approximately three in depth. Each pair shares a one story frame "T" shaped wing two bays wide and one bay in depth, also with a low peaked roof. The building is sheathed with asbestos shingles.

Front entrances occur in the right (north) bays of all houses except in the left on #309 and consist of four panel doors entered by small Victorian porches with turned pillars, spindle cornices and peaked roofs. There is an enclosed passage to the rear yards between #305 & 307.

First floor front windows are of 4/2 sash with 12/2 sash above and #305 & 307 have them grouped in sections of three. There are no side windows and those on the rear are either of 6/6 sash or small horizontal one pane sashes.

Small enclosed square chimneys rise from each end and at the center of the ridge-line.

The building sets on a fieldstone foundation.
