DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

#218 is a 2-1/2 story detached brick house approximately three bays square with a 2-1/2 story brick "L" shaped wing two bays square and a side balcony. There is also a newer story shed roofed extension. All brickwork is in common bond.

The front entrance occupies the right (South) bay with a glass over panels door and rectangular transom. This is approached by a three step porch.

All windows are of 2/2 sash with wood lintels and sills. The attic is lighted by small four pane windows in the gables.

The front section has a rather steep "A" frame metal roof resting on two string brick cornices. A small, square, enclosed chimney rises on the left side. The wing also has a rather steep metal roof.

The house rests on a fieldstone foundation.
