DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This is a detached pair of high, 2-1/2 story frame houses, approximately four bays square with a two story, frame "T" shaped wing, three bays wide and two in depth and a side balcony. The building is now covered by composition siding. Newer doors occupy the end bays and are approached by high wooden porches. All front windows are of 1/1 sash and rear area windows are of 1/1 and 2/2 sash. The front section has a broad, moderate slope "A" frame roof with double flue enclosed chimneys rising from each side, and the wing has a low slope "A" frame, both of metal. The front roofline is ended by a boxed cornice and the wooden frieze is decorated by a band of dentils. This building rests on a low fieldstone foundation with high brick cellar walls. It is fronted by a brick pavement.
