DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

#100 is a low, three story, detached brick house, three bays wide and two in depth with a newer, 2-1/2 story brick "L" shaped wing, approximately two bays square with a side balcony and a lower, 2-1/2 story frame extension, three bays wide and two in depth. All brickwork is in common bond and the frame extension is clapboarded. A glass over panels front door with a two pane overlight occupies the right (W) wing and a set of double 1/1 sash windows with a fluted mullion lies to the left. This is all protected by a covered porch. The front and most side windows and those in the rear sections are of 2/2 sash with some 2/1 and 6/6 sash and all have wood lintels and sills. There is a horizontal, six pane window in the high side of the shed roofed wing. The low, third story is fronted by a Victorian design, shingled mansard roof containing three shallow dormer windows with round arched, four pane sashes. The roof of this front section is of very low "A" frame construction. The wing has a shed roof and the rear extension--a moderate slope "A" frame roof, all being of metal. There is a small enclosed chimney on the end of the rear extension. This house rests on a low fieldstone foundation.
