**DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE**

This is a detached, 2-1/2 story pair of frame houses, four bays wide and two in depth with a 2-1/2 story frame wing of full width and two bays in depth with rear galleries. The building is now completely sheathed with asbestos siding. Glass over panel doors occupy the end bays and are protected by small covered porches with Victorian trim consisting of turned pillars and pilasters, turned banisters, a dentiled cornice supported by turned stick brackets. The doors have narrow overlights. All house windows are of 2/2 sash with louvered shutters on the front. The attic is lighted by two, four pane windows. The front section has a moderate slope "A" frame roof with a double flue chimney rising at the center of the ridge. The wing also has a moderate slope "A" frame roof and both being of metal. There is an overhanging boxed cornice on the front. The building rests on a low brick faced foundation.
