DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This is a pair of detached, 2-1/2 story frame houses, four bays wide and two deep with a 2-1/2 story, frame "T" wing, three bays square with side balconies. The building is now covered with composition siding. Simple glass paned doors with three pane overlights occupy the inner bays. All house windows are of 6/6 sash and the attic is lighted by two, four pane windows in each gable. The front section has a steep slope "A" frame roof with small enclosed chimneys rising from each end and the wing has a moderate slope "A" frame roof with an end chimney and both are of metal. The rooflines are ended by boxed cornices. The pavement is of herringbone patterned brickwork.
