DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This is a two story row of four brick houses detached on the right (W) side, twelve narrow bays wide and two bays in depth. #106 and #112 have "L" shaped wings while #108 and 110 share a "T" shaped wing. All are of two story, brick construction, two bays deep with rear balconies, end wings are two bays square, and center wings are four bays wide. #106 also has a two bay deep, frame extension. All brickwork is of common bond. Simple front entrances with glass over panels doors and two pane overlights occupy the third bay from the left on each house. These are approached by high, six step porches. All front windows are of narrow, 1/1 sash with flat brick arches of shaped voussoirs as above the doors and have louvered shutters. Rear windows are of 4/4 sash, also with flat brick arches. The front section roof slopes to the rear and is fronted by a moulded, boxed cornice. Beneath this is a projecting brick frieze decorated by a band of dentils and moulding. Large, moulded brackets accent the ends of the building. The end wings have shed roofs and the center "T" wing, a low "A" frame. This building rests on a low fieldstone foundation and has high brick cellar walls. These are mostly above ground and have four panel doors and tall windows.
