**DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE**

#107 is a 2-1/2 story brick house attached on the right (E) side and is three bays wide and two in depth with a 2-1/2 story brick "L" shaped wing, two bays wide and four in depth with a side balcony. The house has common bond brickwork with the front facade being restored. The front entranceway occupies the left bay with a newer door, paneled enframingent, and a narrow overlight. First floor front windows are wide and taller than those above, and all are of 1/1 sash with wood lintels and sills. Second floor lintels are decorated by bands of attached pendants joined by round arches. Wing windows are of 6/6 sash except for large, 1/1 sash windows on the rear of the first floor and several retain paneled shutters. The front attic is lighted by a small, four pane window in the left gable, and the wing by a 6/6 window in the end gable. The front section has a moderate slope "A" frame roof of metal embossed in a shingle pattern and rests on two string brick cornices. Double flue enclosed chimneys rise at each end. The wing has a moderate slope, metal shed roof. The house rests on a low fieldstone foundation.
