**DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE**

This is a detached, 2-1/2 story brick pair of houses, four bays wide and two in depth with a 2-1/2 story brick "T" shaped wing, three bays wide and two in depth and side balconies. #109 also has a newer one bay square frame extension. All brickwork is of common bond. Front entrances occupy the outer bays with newer paneled doors, paneled enframements, and three pane overlights. The front windows of #109 are of 6/1 sash while #111 has 1/1 sash, all with moulded top lintels as above the doors and louvered shutters.

Rear windows are of 6/6 sash with wood lintels and sills. The attics are lighted by two, four pane windows in each gable and in the end of the wing. The front section has a moderate slope "A" frame roof resting on two string brick cornices and double flue enclosed chimneys rise on either end. The wing also has a moderate slope roof and both are of metal. The building rests on a low fieldstone foundation and #111 is fronted by a herringbone brick patterned pavement.
