DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

#113 is a two story detached brick house, two bays wide and four in depth with a two story, brick "L" shaped wing, two bays square and a side balcony recently enclosed. All brickwork is in common bond and the front facade has been restored. The front entrance occupies the left (W) bay with an attractive, newer door and an enclosed segmental arched transom. This is approached by an ornamental cast iron porch. To the right is a double window with a decorative moulded mullion, and all front windows are of 1/1 sash with two row header brick arches having infills adorned by roundels and panels. Rear area windows are a combination of 6/6, 1/1 sashes and a newer, vertical pair of casement windows for the kitchen, but lintels or arches are not discernable. The front section roof slopes to the rear and is fronted by an attractive, Victorian "V" shaped cornice trimmed with bands of lozenges and mouldings. The bays are divided and ended by long fluted and moulded brackets. The wing has a shed roof and both are of metal. The house rests on a low fieldstone foundation and is fronted by a herringbone patterned brick pavement.
