**DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE**

This is a detached, two story brick pair of houses, approximately four bays square with a two story, brick "T" shaped wing, three bays wide and two in depth with side balconies and a one story, frame extension. All brickwork is in common bond. Newer doors occupy the outer bays with segmental arched transoms. All front windows are of 1/1 sash with two row brick segmental arches and segmental shaped louvered shutters. Wing windows are of 2/2 sash with wood lintels and sills. The front section roof slopes to the rear and the wing has a low "A" frame roof, both of metal. The front facade is crowned by a Victorian "V" shaped embossed metal cornice decorated with bands of an egg and dart motif, fleur-de-ly and garlands. This is ended by flat brackets bearing designs of fleur-de-ly and foliated motifs. The building rests on a low fieldstone foundation.
