**DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE**

This is a 2-1/2 story brick pair of houses detached on the right side, four bays wide and two in depth with a 2-1/2 story, brick "T" shaped wing, approximately two bays square with side balconies and newer, two story frame and block extensions. Both houses are laid in common bond, but #125 has been stuccoed on the front facade.

Newer doors occupy the right bay of each house. All front windows are of 1/1 sash with #125 now having flat arches, but #127 retaining original, segmental arches. A large, double window with a fluted mullion lights the first floor of #127. The wing contains old, four panel doors and a combination of 2/2, 4/4 and small 6/6 sash windows, all with wood lintels and sills. The attics are lighted by small, four pane windows in each gable.

The front section has a steep, metal "A" frame roof resting on two string brick cornices. Small enclosed chimneys rise at each end. The wing has a moderate slope, "A" frame roof with a large, enclosed chimney in the end.

The building rests on a low fieldstone foundation.
