DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

#107 is a small, brick, 2-1/2 story house detached on the left side, two narrow bays wide and two longer bays in depth with a small, newer extension to the rear. All brickwork is in common bond. The simple front entrance occupies the right bay with a four panel door. All windows are of 2/2 sash with wood lintels and sills. The house has a moderate slope "A" frame roof resting on three string brick cornices and shares half of a large square chimney with #109 near the center of the ridge. The house rests on a low fieldstone foundation.
