DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This is a detached, 2-1/2 story pair of frame houses, approximately four bays square with a two story, frame "T" shaped wing, three bays wide and two in depth and side balconies, enclosed on #213. There is a one story, full-width shed roofed extension to the rear. #213 is completely sheathed with stone patterned asbestos shingles while #215 has asphalt siding on the front and original clapboarding on the exposed side and rear. Front entrances occupy the end bays with #125 retaining a four panel door and both have small overlights. Both houses also have a pair of narrow, 1/1 sash windows with a channeled mullion on the first floor, 2/2 sash above and a small, 2/2 sash pointed top window in the top pediment. The attics are also lighted by a small, four pane window in each gable. There are 6/6 sash windows on the sides and the rear wing. The front facade is crowned by a large shingled pediment centered over each house, trimmed by a band of vertical dentils, as on the cornice. The front section has a moderate slope "A" frame roof covered by asbestos shingles on #213 and metal on #215. The wing has a rather flat "A" frame roof. Small enclosed chimneys rise on each end of the front section. The building rests on a low fieldstone foundation and is fronted by a herringbone patterned brick pavement.
