DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This is a very small three story building. It is three bays wide on the front and has a flat roof over it. Its building material is brick laid in common bond painted pink and the trim is white.

The first floor has a recent metal and glass storefront. On the second and third floors the windows are wood, double hung with 2/2 sash. They have wood sills and brick segmental arches for heads.

Above the third floor windows is the entablature. This consists of a small wood architrave, a brick frieze, and a wood cornice with console modillions. The whole is supported on wood brackets between the bays and at the corners of the building.
