**DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE**

#112 is a 2-1/2 story brick detached house, three bays square with a small gallery on the left, rear section, and the gable faces the street. It is of unpainted brick in common bond. A period door with segmental arched transom occupies the left bay while a large, two story, rectangular-shingled bay window is to the right. The first floor is fronted by a deep covered porch supported by Doric columns. All regular house windows are of 1/1 sash with two row header, segmental brick arches and louvered shutters. The front gable is also shingled and contains a set of three small windows. The roof is of moderate slope "A" frame construction covered by square asbestos tiles. A double chimney rises on the left. This house rests on a low brick-faced foundation.
