DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This is a detached pair of two story brick houses, four bays wide and approximately five bays in depth with rear balconies. All brickwork is in common bond. Simple front entrances occupy the outer bays and #238 retains a four panel door on the front and wing. The first floor is protected by a wide covered porch with turned pillars. Front and side windows are of 1/1 sash and those on the rear area are of 2/2 sash, all with two row header brick segmental arches. The front roof slopes to the rear and is fronted by a plain boxed cornice with thin-cut brackets dividing and ending the houses. The building rests on a low fieldstone foundation.
