DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

#242 is a 2-1/2 story, detached frame house, three bays wide and two in depth with a two story, frame "L" shaped wing, two bays wide and one bay in depth with a rear extension. This house is sheathed with clapboarding, asbestos and plastic sidings. A newer door occupies the center bay. Front windows are of small, 2/2 sash with 6/6 and 2/2 sash in the rear area. The attic is lighted by a four pane window in the left gable. The front section has a moderate slope "A" frame roof and the wing has a shed roof, all of metal. Double flue enclosed chimneys rise from each side. The house rests on a low fieldstone foundation.
