**DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE**

This is a detached row of two story brick houses, nine bays wide and approximately four bays in depth with two, two story brick "T" shaped wings, three bays wide and two in depth with rear balconies and newer, first floor extensions. All brickwork is in common bond. Segmental arched glass over panels doors with two pane overlights occupy the first, third, sixth and eighth bays from the left (E) side and an enclosed passageway to the rear with a board and batten gate and a Victorian-cut grill occupies the fifth bay. Covered porches with turned pillars front each pair of houses. All front windows are of 2/2 sash with two row brick header segmental arches and those on the front have the infills decorated with roundels. Rear windows are mostly 6/6 sash with wood lintels and sills. The front section roof slopes to the rear and the wings have low "A" frames, all of metal. The front roofline has a Victorian, "V" shaped cornice decorated by bands of mouldings and incised designs with narrow, moulded brackets accenting each house. The building rests on a low fieldstone foundation.
