DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This is a 2-1/2 story, detached frame house, two bays wide and four in depth with the gable ends being front to rear. It is said by Mr. Stevens, the owner, that these houses were prefabricated and delivered in sections. It is covered by clapboarding. A turn-of-the-century door occupies the left (W) bay and is protected by a covered porch with turned pillars across the front. All house windows are of 2/2 sash, most with top moulded lintels. The front gable has a small, four pane window with a peaked decoration centered by a lozenge and roundel. This gable is fronted by a decorative shingle pattern in fishscale and crosshatch designs. The house has a steep slope "A" frame slate roof with square chimneys with deeply corbelled caps rising from the front and rear third of the ridge. It rests on a low fieldstone foundation.
