DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This is a 2-1/2 story brick attached building three bays square with an added full width one story commercial type wing which is two bays long and a full width two story two bay long extension. There are presently no balconies. All brickwork is of painted common bond. The first floor contains a shop with an entrance in the right bay. The woodwork is rather plain except for fluted panels on either side. A boxed cornice with a pent roof runs across the second floor level. This building was obviously built as a federal style house before revisions. The second floor front windows, as well as those on the rear, are of 6/6 sash with wood lintels and sills. One rear window is protected by old three panel shutters. Rear wing doors are of board and batten. The front section roof is a moderate slope "A" frame covered by asphalt shingles. No chimneys are visible unless shared with adjacent buildings. The wings have metal shed roofs with a small chimney on the center area. The front section roofline is ended by a box cornice on the front and a moulded cornice on the rear. The building rests on a fairly low foundation.
