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## DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This is a 2-1/2 story Colonial style brick home located on a corner site. It is four bays wide and three bays deep with an added "L" shaped streetside wing being four bays by one bay in depth and side and front section rear balconies. The front and left sides are laid in Flemish bond while the wing is in common bond. A colonial rounded brick watertable and a three string brick belt course between the first and second stories continues from the front around the left side of the front section. An entranceway lies in the second bay from the left and contains a six panel door with a colonial four pane overhead and is framed by a paneled soffit and enclosure and headed by a plain wood lintel. This is reached by a six step sandstone porch with iron railing. Front windows are of 6/6 sash with wood lintels and sills. All windows on the front, side, and rear areas are protected by louvered shutters. The left gable has a small 2/2 sash lighting the attic and other front section side windows are of 6/6 and narrow 4/4 sash with wood lintels and sills. Wing windows are of 2/2 and 2/1 sash with wood lintels and sills. Rear area doors are paneled. The front section roof is a metal moderate slope "A" frame with wide enclosed chimneys rising from the gables. Both ends of the gable and the front roofline are trimmed by a moulded cornice. The wing has a metal shed roof and the streetside has a very ornate Victorian cornice consisting of a row of raised blocks with roundels, a row of slender pointed pendants, a band of small lozenges, and four carved brackets. This building rests on a high fieldstone foundation. There is a courtyard to the rear and side.
