## DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This is a three story brick attached building being six bays wide and two bays in depth with two story "U" shaped wings with newer extensions. #431 has a one-bay wide wing three bays long with a side balcony and a two-bay wide, three-bay long newer addition. #435 has a wing which is one bay wide and seven bays long without any noticeable breaks in the brickwork. A four-bay long extension is added to this wing. The living area appears to end at the fourth bay with a short side balcony and the rest of the wing is built up higher and contains several large industrial type windows. The left section of the building is residential with a rather plain entrance in the center bay, has a 1/1 sash window to the left, and an enclosed entrance-way to the right fronted by a metal bar gate. The right section contains a rather modern plain glass and metal shopfront with an entrance to the upper floors to the right. This section is covered by a box cornice trimmed by a row of dentils. All front upper story windows are of 2/2 sash with flat brick jack arches. All rear section windows on the original wings are of 2/2 or 6/6 sash with wood lintels and sills and the doors are paneled. Louvered shutters protect most of these windows. All brickwork is of common bond. The roof of the front section is rather flat and has a double chimney rising from the center. The wings and extensions have metal shed roofs. The roofline is fronted by a protruding cornice moulded at the top with a row of fluted modillions under the soffit and supported by long moulded brackets separating and ending the bays. These are adorned by square bosses with crosses "pattee"  , fluting and leaf motif pendants. Panels of raised moulding lie between the brackets on the frieze. The building has a low foundation. A long flower garden extends to the rear of #431.
