DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

#22 is a 2-1/2 story brick house detached on the left (E) side, three bays wide and approximately three bays in depth with a two story brick "L" shaped wing two bays wide and four bays in depth with a side balcony and a two story brick dependency and smoke house. The classical front entrance occupies the right bay with a newer door of small panes, white marble sill, and a three pane overlight with a half round moulded transom bar. This is all enclosed by Doric pilasters trimmed with scallops as on the window lintels, supporting a flat entablature trimmed with Roman dentils. The doorway is approached by a rather high cement porch with iron railings. All front windows are of unusual 4/4 sash with wood sills and moulded top lintels decorated with a band of scallops as on #18 & 20. There is a 6/6 JIB window-door on the second story of the rear of the front section and wing windows are of 6/6 sash except for a small 4+4 sash casement window on the rear, and all have wood lintels and sills, most with louvered shutters. The attic is lighted by a small four pane window in the left gable. Rear doors are of four panels with three pane overlights. The front section has a moderate slope "A" frame roof resting on three string cornices and a very wide enclosed chimney rises from the left side. The wing has a shed roof and both are of metal. This house rests on a rather high fieldstone foundation. It is fronted by a herringbone brick patterned pavement and has a brick side yard patio, partly in old hexagon bricks. Brickwork is in common bond.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

This is a typical large Federal home of the period with all the usual features including the classical entranceway and with a slight touch of Victorian in the decorated lintels and pilasters. It is well maintained and an asset to the streetscape.

The rear wing may possibly be older than the front section because of softer bricks, log rafters under the first floor and a difference in floor levels.
