DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This is a detached brick 1-1/2 story pair of small houses four bays wide and two bays in depth sharing a two story brick "T" shaped wing, three bays wide and two bays in depth with side balconies and a two story frame extension of two bays in depth. All brickwork is of common bond and #28 has been recently restored. Front entrances occupy the inner bays with #28 retaining a four panel door and three pane overlight. All front windows are of 1/1 sash and the small casement "lie on your stomach" type windows lighting the top story are also of one pane sash. 6/6 sash are retained for rear windows and all have wood lintels and sills except for brick sills on the front of the first floor. The front attic section is lighted by two small four pane windows in each gable. The front section has a moderate slope "A" frame roof resting on three string brick cornices and double flue enclosed chimneys rise from each end. The wing roof slopes to the rear and both are of metal. This building rests on a low fieldstone foundation and is fronted by a herringbone patterned brick pavement.
