DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This is a 2-1/2 story brick pair of houses detached on the right (W) side, five bays wide and approximately three in depth with two story brick "U" shaped wings, two bays deep and 1-1/2 bays wide with end balconies. All brickwork is in common bond. Simple front entrances with newer doors and segmental arched transoms occupy the inner bays. An enclosed passageway to rear yards is located in the center. Front windows are of 2/2 sash with louvered shutters and segmental brick arches. Rear windows are a combination of 1/1 and 6/6 sash with wood lintels and sills. The attics are lighted by a 6/6 sash peaked dormer window on the rear of each house. The front section has a moderate slope "A" frame roof resting on three string brick cornices and double flue enclosed chimneys rise from each side. The wing roofs are rather flat. This pair of houses rests on a low fieldstone foundation and is fronted by a herringbone patterned brick pavement.
