DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

#40 is a 2-1/2 story brick house detached on the left (E) side, three bays wide and two bays in depth with a two story brick "L" shaped wing two bays in depth and one bay wide with a side balcony and one story brick extension two bays deep and one bay wide. All brickwork is in common bond. According to sidewall evidence this was originally a 1-1/2 story house. The front entranceway occupies the right (W) bay with a newer door, paneled enframement and four pane overlight. All front windows are of 2/2 sash with ornate segmental brick arches decorated by central "keystones" of long shaped voussoirs, the lower row of headers is recessed, and the infills are decorated with roundels as above the front door. Rear windows are of 6/6 sash with wood lintels and sills and the attic is lighted by two 4/2 sash windows in the left gable. The front section has a broad moderate slope "A" frame roof resting on three string brick cornices and a wide enclosed chimney rises from the left side. The wing has a moderate slope shed roof and both are of metal. The house rests on a low fieldstone foundation.
