DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This is a detached pair of 2-1/2 story brick houses four bays wide and two bays in depth with a "T" shaped 1-1/2 story brick wing three bays wide and two bays in depth. All brickwork is in common bond of an old soft handmade type. Newer doors occupy the inner bays with three pane overlights and are approached by a double covered porch with Victorian cut banisters and incised cornice panels. Front windows are now of 1/1 sash and rear windows are mostly 6/6 sash, all with wood lintels and sills. The front section and wing both have moderate slope "A" frame metal roofs with the front section resting on two string brick cornices. Double flue enclosed chimneys rise from each gable and these attics are lighted by four pane gable windows. The wing has a wide enclosed chimney rising from the end and side rooflines form an overhang. This building rests on a low fieldstone foundation and is fronted by a herringbone patterned brick pavement.
