DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

#11 is a 2-1/2 story brick house detached on the left (W) side, three bays wide and two bays in depth with a two story brick "L" shaped wing two bays wide and four bays deep with a side balcony. All brickwork is in common bond. The front entrance occupies the right bay with a newer door, paneled enframingent, Doric pilasters, and a flat entablature. All front windows are now of 1/1 sash with moulded top lintels. The wing has 6/6 sash with wood lintels and sills and the attic is lighted by two four pane windows in the left side. The front section has a steep slope "A" frame roof resting on three string brick cornices and a double flue enclosed chimney rises on the left. The wing has a shed roof and both are of metal. The house sets on a high fieldstone foundation and is fronted by a herringbone patterned brick pavement.
