DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

#21 is a tall, two story brick house detached on the right (E) side, four bays wide and three bays in depth with a two story "L" shaped brick wing on the first floor and frame covered by clapboard on the second story. There is also a deteriorated side balcony and small brick extension. All brickwork is in common bond. The front entrance occupies the center bay with a newer glass over panel door, paneled enframe- ment, three pane transom, and all enclosed by a wide moulded architrave. This is approached by a high, nine step wooden porch. On either side are double 1/1 sash windows with moulded mullions, decorated lugsills and headed by flat brick arches of long shaped voussoirs. On the second story are 2/2 sash windows with moulded top lintels. There are 6/6 sash windows with wood lintels and sills and old four and six panel doors with overlights on the rear area. The front roof slopes to the rear and the wing has a shed roof. The front roof cornice is enhanced by a band of large dentils and ended by cyma curved grooved brackets. The house sets on high field- stone walls forming an English basement at ground level. This is entered from the front by a wide door with a paneled enframe- ment and is lighted by two 6/6 sash windows.
