DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

#110 is a tall, 1-1/2 story brick detached house, three bays wide and two bays in depth with a lower two story brick and frame "L" shaped wing two bays square with a side balcony and one story dependency. All brickwork is common bond. A newer door occupies the left (E) bay with a paneled enframing and old four pane overlight. First floor windows are of 6/6 sash with wood lintels and sills and there are 4+4 pane casement "lie on your stomach" style windows above. In the rear are small 6/6 sash windows with wood lintels and sills and old four panel doors. The front section has a steep slope "A" frame roof resting on three string brick cornices and double flue enclosed chimneys rise from each end. The wing has a shed roof and both are of metal.

The house rests on a rather high fieldstone foundation with the cellar half above ground. It is fronted by a brick pavement.
