DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

#149 is a 2-1/2 story frame house three bays wide and two bays in depth with a two story frame "L" shaped wing one bay wide and two bays in depth with a side balcony. The front facade has been sheathed in asphalt shingles. The simple front entrance occupies the left (W) bay with an old four panel door and four pane overlight. This is reached by a wood and concrete stoop. All house windows are of small 6/6 sash and those on the front have louvered shutters. Wing doors are of board and batten construction with four pane overlights and interior doors are less than 6' high. The front section has a moderate slope "A" frame roof with a small enclosed chimney in the right end. The wing has a shed roof and both are of metal. This house rests on a low fieldstone foundation and is fronted by a brick pavement.
