DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This is a tall, 2-1/2 story detached brick pair of houses, four bays wide and approximately three bays in depth. #154 has a nearby full width, two story brick wing beveled into the front section and is two bays in depth with a four bay deep brick extension and long side balcony. Simple front entrances occupy the inner bays with four panel doors and segmental arched overlights. Centered between these is an enclosed passageway to the rear yards. Front windows are now of 1/1 sash with two row header brick arches. Rear area windows are of 2/2 sash, also with two row header arches. The front section has a high steep slope "A" frame roof resting on two string brick cornices and small enclosed brick chimneys rise from each end. The wing has a shed roof and both are of metal. The building rests on a low fieldstone foundation and is fronted by a brick pavement.
