DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This is a two story brick attached pair of houses. The building is four bays wide and two bays in depth with "U" shaped, two story wings of four bays depth and one bay wide with balconies on the inner sides. All brickwork is of painted common bond. Single doorways with molded wood lintels occupy the central bays. These contain single doors of four panels and overlights with dentil trimmed transom bars. Between these is an enclosed passage to the rear gardens, fronted by a board and batten gate with decorative grill work above and topped by a heavy lintel. The front windows are of 2/2 panes with molded lintels matching the doorways. Side and rear windows have 6/6 panes with wood lintels and sills and louvered shutters on #113. The paneled rear doors have overlights. The front section has a metal roof sloping slightly to the rear and the wings have metal shed roofs sloping toward the center. Chimneys are not visible. The front roofline is adorned with a bracketed Victorian style, incised cornice in a floral design. The rear edge of the roofline is supported by a Federal style, two string brick cornice. This building rests on a low fieldstone foundation. To the rear of the houses are long tree shaded yards planted in grass and flowers.
