DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This is a tall, brick, rectangular, commercial building detached on the left side. It is four stories in height, three bays wide and approximately nine bays in depth. The front facade is faced with a tan colored, narrow, pressed brick while the sides and the rear are of regular brick, all in common bond. A high front recessed doorway occupies the left bay and contains double glass paned doors and is approached by two granite steps. Adjoining this are large show windows extending across the bays. This and the doorway are headed by a transom area of narrow, pointed end leaded glass panels. The whole is unified by a molded cornice and a brownstone band which also separates the third and fourth stories. Second and third story front windows are of one pane headed by leaded glass panels as on the first floor. These windows are grouped into two story panels framed by a pattern of two row headers alternately protruding. Fourth floor front windows, also of one pane are topped by a triple row of 7/1/7 small sash with heavy brownstone lintels with keystones. Rear and side windows are of 2/2 sash with segmental brick header arches. The entire roof is of a slight slope to the rear. A simple molded box cornice fronts the roofline and beneath it is a protruding frieze ornamented by floral garlands and roundels with a molded baseline. This building rests on a very low foundation. Because of the different design, obviously the fourth floor was a later addition.
