DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

#187 is a 2-1/2 story detached brick house three bays wide and two bays in depth with a two story brick "L" shaped wing 1-1/2 bays wide and four bays in depth and a side balcony. All brickwork is in common bond. A glass over panels door with a three pane overhead occupies the left (W) bay. All front windows are now of 6/1 sash and the rear area retains 6/6 sash, all with wood lintels and sills. The attic is lighted by a small four pane window in each gable and in the end of the wing. The front section has a moderate slope "A" frame roof resting on two string brick cornices and double flue enclosed chimneys rise from each end. The wing has a shed roof and both are covered by asphalt shingles. The house rests on a low fieldstone foundation.
