DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

#114 is a detached 2-1/2 story brick house three bays wide and two bays in depth with a one story frame "L" shaped wing two bays square. All brickwork is in common bond. The simple front entrance occupies the left (N) bay with an old four panel door and four pane overlight. Front windows are now of 1/1 sash but those on the rear area remain 6/6 sash, all with wood lintels and sills. There are louvered shutters on the front and paneled shutters on the rear of the front section. The attic is lighted by a small, four pane window in the right gable. The front section has a steep slope "A" frame roof resting on two string brick cornices and a wide enclosed chimney rises from the left gable. The wing has a shed roof and both are of metal. This house rests on a low fieldstone foundation and is fronted by a brick pavement.
