DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This is a 2-1/2 story brick Federal house detached on the left side. It is approximately three bays square with an "L" shaped, two story brick wing two bays wide and five bays long with a side balcony. All brickwork is in common bond and the front has been restored. The very attractive front entranceway occupies the right bay with a six panel door, projecting moulding panel enframement, a three pane overlight, and the whole is framed by plain pilasters and a flat entablature decorated by small modillions and supported by Victorian fluted and moulded brackets. A colonial lamp lights the way. Front windows are all of 2/2 sash with moulded lintels trimmed by very small dentils and are protected by louvered shutters. There is an old 6/6 JIB window-door on the rear of the front section and the wing has 6/6 sash with wood lintels and sills and there is an old six panel door. The attic is lighted by a small sash in the left gable. The front section has a moderate slope "A" frame roof resting on three string brick cornices and enclosed double chimneys rise from each gable. The wing has a shed roof and both are of metal. The house is set on a low fieldstone foundation. The front of the house is enhanced by a very attractive foundation planting of evergreens fronted by a low brick wall, and the brick pavement is laid in a herringbone pattern. On the left of the wing is a brick paved patio with holly plantings, and to the rear is a small garden with a stone walk, trees, various hollys, and a central fountain. The interior has been attractively renovated for modern living, but retain an old brick kitchen fireplace and a boxed stairway to rear rooms.
