**DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE**

This is a 2-1/2 story brick house detached on the left and approximately three bays square with an "L" shaped brick, two story wing 1-1/2 bays wide and four bays long with a side balcony and a one bay square two story extension. All brickwork is in common bond and the front has been restored. The front entranceway occupies the right bay with a newer Victorian doorway consisting of a glass over panels door, paneled enframing, and framed by tall, wide pilasters with grooved panel-like trim and headed by a recessed panel of a multi-curved shape, all topped by a boxed cornice. The doorsill and two step porch are of red sandstone, showing much wear and has wrought iron railings. First floor front windows are of 1/1 sash and those on the second story are of 6/6 sash and all have wood sills and lintels with square end blocks carved with roundels and protected by louvered shutters. Wing windows are of 6/6 sash with wood lintels and sills. The attic is lighted by a 6/3 sash window from the left side. There are rear doors of six panels with four pane overlights and the wing extension, probably an early dependency, has two board and batten doors side by side on the first floor. The front section has a steep sloped "A" frame roof supported by three string cornices on the front and rear and the sidewalls rise to form roof curtains with end buttresses. Double chimneys are enclosed in each end wall and are joined by curtains at the roof level. The building rests on a rather low fieldstone foundation.
