DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This is a three story brick attached building three bays wide and approximately five bays long. All brickwork is in common bond. The first floor is occupied by a shop with large glass panes and an entrance in the left bay to the second floor offices. Second story front windows are of 1/1 sash and the third story has 6/6, all with flat brick arches. There are no rear or side windows. The roof, with a tar finish, slopes to the rear. There is a stepped wall on the right side with an enclosed chimney. A simple moulded cornice with dentil trim fronts the roofline. The building rests on a low foundation. The upper stories of this building retain their appearance of 100 years ago except for former shutters and painted signs on the wall.
