**DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE**

This is a 2-1/2 story brick attached building three bays wide and two bays in depth with a two story brick "L" shaped wing, two short bays wide, two long bays, and with a rear balcony. The front facade has been covered with "formstone." The end bays contain doorways with the shop entrance and window on the left combined by a simple moulded cornice with modillion trim. Second story front windows are of small 2/2 sash and those on the rear area are 1/1, 2/2, and 6/6 sash. The front section has a rather steep slope metal "A" frame roof with a small enclosed chimney rising behind the left gable. The wing has a shed roof of composition material. The two or three string brick cornices have been hidden by wooden boxed cornices. The building rests on a rather low foundation and is fronted by a herringbone pattern brick pavement.
