**DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE**

This is a 2-1/2 story brick house detached on the right side, four bays wide and two bays in depth with a two story brick "L" shaped wing two bays wide and five bays long which probably had a side balcony. The front facade is laid in Flemish bond and all other is in common bond. The front and exposed side have been recently restored. The entranceway occupies the second bay from the left and is in a very attractive late Federal style with a four paneled door and paneled enframing--both rounded at the top, a one pane overlight with a wide moulded transom bar, brass colonial lanterns on either side, and a white marble doorsill. There is a Federal period design signboard hanging from a wrought iron bracket over the doorway. All front windows are now of 1/1 sash with louvered shutters and wood lintels as over the doorway. There is an old cast iron cellar window closure in the right bay. Rear area windows run the gauntlet from various sizes of 6/6, 6/4, 6/1, 2/2, and 1/1 sash, all with wood lintels and sills. There are now paneled doors on the rear. The front section has a moderate slope "A" frame roof with double flue enclosed chimneys rising from either gable and the wing has a shed roof--both of metal. The front section roof rests on a two string brick cornice on the front and rear. The building sets on a low fieldstone foundation. It is fronted by a herringbone pattern brick pavement.
