DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This is a two story brick detached former home being four bays wide and two bays in depth with an "L" shaped, two story brick wing being two bays wide and four bays long with a side balcony. All brickwork is in common bond. The entrance-way occupies the second bay from the right with a four paneled door, paneled enframement, and an overlight. First floor front windows have 2/2 sash with wood lintels and sills and those on the second story have 6/6 sash with moulded top lintels. Rear area windows are of 6/6 sash with wood lintels and sills and there are glass over panels doors. The roof of the front section slopes to the rear with stepped sidewalls and the wing has a slight slope shed roof--both of metal. There are boxed wood cornices on the front and rear with the front supported by closely spaced moulded brackets with turned pendants. This building rests on a high foundation. There is a long yard to the rear.
