DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

#326 is a 2-1/2 story brick detached home except for a low former shop on the left. It is approximately three bays square with an "L" shaped 2-1/2 story brick wing five bays long and two bays wide with a deep side gallery and a small brick "necessity" on the end. All brickwork is in common bond. On the left is a 1-1/2 story, two bay square, former shop section built with the house. This has a small cement block extension. The entranceway of #326 occupies the right bay with a six panel door, paneled enframingent, a four pane overlight, and moulded transom bar. This is approached by a cement stoop. All windows on #326 are of 6/6 sash. The first floor front has flat brick arches of long voussoirs with protruding brick keystones as over the door. The second story has grooved wood lintels with square end blocks carved with roundels. All rear windows have regular wood lintels and sills. Rear doors have four panels and four pane overlights. #324 has a glass over panels front door, a four pane overlight with wood lintels and a double 6/6 sash window with wood lintel and sill. The front section attic is lighted by a nine sash window in each gable as is the left gable of the shop. The front section has a steep slope "A" frame roof resting on a three string brick cornice, front and rear. There is an enclosed double chimney joined by curtains rising from each gable. The wing also has a steep slope "A" frame roof and the shop section is covered by a low slope "A" frame roof resting on two string brick cornices, front and rear, and all roofin is of metal. The building rests on a low fieldstone foundation. There is a neglected long yard to the rear.
