This is a 2-1/2 story brick pair of houses detached on the left side and five bays wide and two bays in depth. #364 is three bays wide with a two story "L" shaped frame wing approximately three bays long and two bays wide with a side balcony and a 1/2 bay block extension. #366 is two bays wide with a two story brick "L" shaped wing three bays long and 1-1/2 bays wide.
