**DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE**

This is a three story detached duplex, four bays wide and three bays deep with a four bay long "T" shaped wing. All brickwork is of painted common bond. A one story, one bay frame addition adjoins the wing on the rear. There are balconies on both sides of the two story wing. Recessed doorways occupy the first and third bays from the west. They are enframed by plain, three section round moulded pilasters with moulding forming a segmental arch centered by a carved decoration. The doors are of sash with paneling and are headed by overlights. Both sides are approached by five step brick porches with iron railings. The double first floor windows are separated by mullions and headed by flat brick arches. These above have single panes with segmental brick arches and wood sills. Metal window box grills add to the appearance on the first floor. Front basement windows also have segmental arches. Wing windows are of 6/6 sash with wood lintels and sills and some have louvered shutters. On the sidewall of #107 is a triangular shaped leaded stained glass window.

The front section has a flat metal roof sloping to the rear and the wing is covered by a moderate slope, metal "A" frame roof. Chimneys are not visible. The front roofline is capped by a Victorian cornice with brackets, carved roundels, pointed and carved modillions, a band of incised diamond designs across the center of the frieze, and the brackets are tied together by another band of designs. The basement is of fieldstone.

A herringbone brick pavement fronts both houses and there are flower gardens and brick patios to the rear.
