DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This is a three story brick pair of attached houses, four bays wide and approximately three bays in depth with 2-1/2 story brick "U" shaped wings, 1-1/2 bays wide and four bays in depth with end balconies. Front entrances occupy the inner bays with glass over panel doors, white marble sills, segmentally arched transoms, and dentiled transom bars. First floor front windows are double and those above are single, all with 1/1 sash and segmental brick arches with infills adorned by roundels, as above the doors. Rear area windows are of 6/6 sash with small four pane windows in the rear of the attics. The front section roof slopes to the rear and the wings have moderate slope shed roofs. The front Victorian "V" shaped cornice is quite ornate with bands of "V" shaped incisions, square floral motifs, pointed dentils, and quatrefoils. Moulded brackets accent the bays. The building rests on a low foundation.
